INVITATION FOR BID (IFB)
(LOCAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING)

1.0 The Maharashtra State Electricity Transmission Company Limited Mumbai, herein after referred to as the 'Owner' (MSETCL) invites bids through SRM e-tendering system in TWO bids system (Techno- commercial Bid & Price Bid) from eligible bidders in India for executing civil works for "Work of construction of new school building of Kendriya Prathamik Shala, Gadmodshingi, Tal. Karveer, Dist. Kolhapur".

3.0 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT

Compulsory Primary Documents:

- i) Valid Certificate of Registration of appropriate class from PWD/MES/Railways/Jeevan Pradhikaran. etc. OR from Any Govt./Semi Govt. & Central Government. Undertaking regarding exemption availed by the agency having registration value more than 1.5 crores in case of PWD.
- ii) GST Registration certificate having active status.
- iii) Statement of Net worth during the last year ending 31st March of previous financial year for an amount equal to 25% of the cost put to tender duly certified by Chartered Accountant. Net Worth = Equity share capital + Reserves – Revaluation reserves – Intangible assets – Miscellaneous expenditure to the extent not written off and carry forward losses. The bidder should submit statement of Net worth duly certified by the Chartered Accountant. (with UDIN number)
- iv) Average Financial Turn-over during the last three years ending 31st March of previous financial year should be at least 30% of the cost put to tender. The agency has to submit

Annual Turnover Report and audited financial statements of last 3 years duly certified by Chartered Accountant/Registered Income Tax Practitioner. (with UDIN number)

- v) Agency has to submit the Certificate of Experience for execution of works in Govt. organization duly signed by the officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent in case of Govt. works.

Experience of having successfully completed similar civil works as defined below during the last 7 years ending the last day of month previous to one in which the tenders are invited should be either of following.

- a) " Three completed similar works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the cost put to tender.

OR

- b) "Two completed similar works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the cost put to tender

OR

- c) "One completed similar work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the cost put to tender.

Definition of Similar Works:- Building Construction works only.

- vi) E.P.F. Registration Certificate. (P.F. Act)
vii) Payment of EMD online /BG @ 1% of estimated cost.
viii) Solvency certificate of Nationalized or Scheduled Bank equivalent to an amount not less than 25% of the estimated cost of Tender.
ix) Income Tax return for last three financial years.
x) PAN card.
xi) Undertaking to be submitted by the Bidder declaring that Bidder is not Debarred/Blacklisted by Government/Semi-Government/Other Power Utilities.
xii) Bidders should visit the proposed site and submit Undertaking regarding confirmation of site visit in attached format with photographic evidence.
xiii) Undertaking on Non Judicial stamp paper of Rs. 500/- that the documents are genuine, authentic, true & valid. (undertaking format attached)

Note: The original colored scan copy should be uploaded as bid documents in support of Technical Qualifying Criteria. The Attested/Notarized photocopies of the same will not be entertained. Detailed communication address, e-mail ID & contact numbers of end users should be furnished for cross verification.

4.0 General Points:-


- 4.1 The prices to be quoted against this IFB shall be in Indian Rupees only.

- 4.2 A complete set of documents can be downloaded by the bidder from MSETCL's SRM –e Tendering website. The cost of bidding documents should be paid online at the time of bid submission.
- 4.3 Bid security deposit (BSD)/Earnest money deposit (EMD) for an amount equal to 1% (one percent) of the estimated cost of tender online/ in the form of Bank Guarantee from scheduled/Nationalized Bank in the prescribed format annexed in the tender specification, along with the offer. The validity of bank guarantee should at least be for six (6) months from originally scheduled date of techno commercial bid opening. The bank guarantee should be payable at Kolhapur only. The stamp duty should be paid as applicable in Maharashtra. The original copy of BG (Hard copy) shall be submitted before last date of submission of bill in the office of Superintending Engineer (C), Kolhapur.
- 4.4 The tender is invited on percentage basis. For Evaluation of the Tender, the total price including all taxes & duties shall be considered. The LOA will be placed on the final accepted price including all applicable Taxes & duties.
- 4.5 Variation in Statutory Taxes / Duties (if any)/ royalty of material will not be payable.

- 4.7 For participation in SRM e-Tendering, registration of bidder in SRM e-Tendering system is essential.
- 4.8 The new bidders are requested to complete the contractor registrations for SRM e-tendering with MSETCL as per the procedure prior to the date of submission of the tender documents.
- 4.9 Please note that pre-qualifying documents issued by the concerned appropriate competent authority on or before last ending day of on-line submission of technical bid documents and Commercial bid i.e. upto due date will be considered for technical bid purpose. The documents of technical bid issued by competent authority after last ending day will not be considered. Commercial bid will be opened on same day or thereafter, after the evaluation of technical bid.”
- 5.0 Bidders have to submit an undertaking in the attached proforma ANNEXURE-G declaring that their Firm is not Debarred/Blacklisted by Government/Semi-Government/Other Power Utilities, anywhere. If it is revealed that the participating Bidder is Debarred/Blacklisted by Any Government/Semi-Government/Other Power Utilities, anywhere, the Offer of such Bidder shall be liable for rejection at any stage of Tendering process. Further, if it is revealed that the successful Bidder is Debarred/Blacklisted by Any Government/Semi-

Government/Other Power Utilities, anywhere, then Order of such Bidder shall be liable for termination at any stage of Order execution process and the concern Bidder shall be solely responsible for the consequences arising there from.
