- f) In case the due date for sale, receipt and/or opening of bid happens to be a holiday, the next working day shall be the corresponding due date.
- g) The tenderer requesting amendment/ seeking clarification in the tender may notify to the purchaser in writing at the Purchaser's mailing address within 2 Days of publication of Notice of Tender. The Purchaser will respond in writing within 4 days of publication of Notice of Tender to any request for clarification of the tender documents, which it receives within the stipulated time (i.e. 2 days). The requests received after stipulated time will not be considered.
- f) After opening of Techno-commercial bid of the tender, during evaluation and comparison of bids, the purchaser may, at his discretion, ask the bidder for clarifications on the bid. The same will be advertised as 'Deviation Bid' on SRM e-tendering portal. The bidder shall note the details in this regard given in clause no. 23.0 of General Conditions of Tender, Book-I (GTC).
- 2.0 The brief scope of the work will be as under:

Supply of Equipment/ Material, Erection, Testing and Commissioning of installation of 1 x 125 MVAR, 3 Phase, 400 kV Bus Reactor (Shunt Reactor) and bay at 400 kV R.S. Dn., New Koyna S/Stn under EHV PCC O&M Zone, Karad on Turnkey basis.

(For above works Reactor will be provided by MSETCL)

The detailed scope of work is briefed as below:

- **A.** Erection, Testing and commissioning of 1 x 125 MVAR, 3 Phase, 400 kV Bus Reactor (Shunt Reactor) and bay and its allied equipment.
- **B.** Supply of all equipment (excluding bus reactor which will be supplied by MSETCL) and other allied materials as per standards mentioned in Technical specification from approved MSETCL vendors mentioned in the list in supply schedule / published on MSETCL website.
- C. Assembly, erection, filtration, testing and commissioning of Reactor.
- **D.** Erection, testing and commissioning of all equipment.
- **E.** Cabling, Earthing, Jumpering etc. and all allied works.
- **F.** Necessary Civil works.

The scope of work given above is only indicative and detailed scope is described elsewhere in the bid documents. Only applicable technical specifications (out of attached documents) as per the scope of works shall be referred to by the bidder.

3.0 **General Points**:

- a) The prices to be quoted against this IFB shall be in Indian rupees only.
- b) The tender is invited on **percentage basis** for Supply + ETC + CIVIL.

- c) For Evaluation of the Tender, the total price of Supply + ETC + CIVIL works including GST & Duties shall be considered.
- d) It should be noted by the Bidders that, Labour welfare cess at the rate of 1% of total amount of contract (Supply+ETC+Civil) will be deducted from the bills.
- e) The LOA/work order will be placed on lowest (L1) final accepted price for Supply + ETC+ Civil works including Labour Cess, GST & Duties.
- f) Bidder should submit all the Schedules duly signed and filled with relevant information.
- g) A complete set of documents can be downloaded by the bidder from MSETCL's SRM e-Tendering website https://srmetender.mahatransco.in The cost of bidding documents should be paid online before submission of offer/ response and the screen shot of successful payment transaction shall be uploaded with bid documents being submitted by the bidder.
- h) The tender is invited as In-divisible composite works contract on uniform percentage basis. Bidders are requested to quote their offer as single percentage for all portions i.e. Supply, ETC and Civil portion and same percentage will be applicable for each item of price breakup. If a bidder submits a non-uniform percentage, MSETCL reserves the right to adjust the bid by applying the overall percentage uniformly across all portions (i.e., Supply, ETC, and Civil portions), and this adjustment will be binding on the bidder. The tender will be considered as In-divisible Composite Works Contract in totality.
- i) The Contract shall be awarded on quoted price inclusive Labour Cess, GST & Duties. 100% GST payment shall be made against invoice submission. All other provisions of the tender remain in full force and effect, other than any provision that conflicts with the terms and spirit of this tender, which shall be deemed to be amended appropriately in order to be consistent with clause.
- j) The price variation will be applicable as detailed in Clause No. 7.0, Terms and Conditions of Contract, Book-I (GTC) of tender document.
- k) In case of any variation in statutory taxes/duties/levy or any new existing tax/duty/levy is revoked by the Government, the same shall be passed through either side. In certain cases production of valid documentary proof may be sought for.
- 1) All the statutory charges/fees for obtaining NOCs from various government department, forest clearances, police protection & TILR charges etc. if required, will be reimbursed to the contractor by owner on submission of documentary evidence.
- m) The quantities for supply, ETC and Civil items are tentative and may vary. Actual materials and quantities to be supplied are to be worked out on detailed engineering. Any "extra item" that may be essential and required for completion of project, shall be supplied by the bidder along-with its ETC and required civil work. The rate of extra item(s) shall be calculated based on latest available purchase order in last two years with MSETCL, latest SoR, the rate quoted by the bidder for this tender and through budgetary

- offer. The lowest of these rates will be considered. The Extra item should not be more than 05% of Work Order Value.
- n) The price variation will be applicable to the items as indicated in Clause no. 8.0, Terms and Conditions of Contract, Book-I (GTC) of tender document. Price variation shall be given on Ex-works price mentioned in MSETCL's estimation in price schedules or bidder's quoted ex-works price whichever is less.
- o) It may please be noted that the taxes / duties will be paid / reimbursed as per actual OR as stated in price break-up statement whichever is lower, on submission of valid documentary proof.
- p) In tender Book -III i.e. Price Estimate of work, the Freight & Insurance and Labour Cess is included in the Ex-Works price of the item(s) unless mentioned separately. Bidder will have to denote F&I and Labour Cess separately for each item in price schedule.
- r) The bidders are requested to submit their financial documents (Turnover & Networth certificate) duly audited, verified & certified figures from Chartered Accountant and same should be generated with UDIN number so that the same can be verified on http://udin.icai.org.
- s) Bidder has to carry out site visit and submit jointly signed site visit certificate with their Techno-Commercial Bid.

- u) The new bidders are requested to complete the supplier registrations for SRM e-Tendering with MSETCL as per the procedure indicated on the website well in advance to the date of submission of the tender documents. Note that MSETCL shall not be responsible for any delay in bid submission due to non-registration of supplier on SRM etendering portal. The bids of only registered main/lead bidders will be entertained.
- v) The circular for Clarification on Price Variation calculations & Direct Online Payment of Land (RoW)/Crop/Tree Compensation to land owners/farmers from MSETCL account is applicable. (Please refer circular no. 2079 dtd. 22.03.2022 & circular no. 2645 dtd. 08.04.2022 attached in tender documents).
- w) <u>Special Note:</u> It is to note that, at the time of opening of this Tender, the ongoing works of Transformer / ICT Augmentation/ Reactor work, i.e. awarded / in hand, should be less than Eight (8) only within the MSETCL.
 - The maximum number of Transformer / ICT augmentation/ Reactor works including this Tender shall be limited to Eight (8) only. If the same is more than Eight (8) it will not be considered as per eligibility criteria & liable for straight away rejection.
 - In the cases wherein the Tender consists of more than One (1) work, the works allotted will be decided on the number of existing works in hand with L1 bidder. If there is work,

after fulfilling eligibility criteria by L1 bidder, the undersigned reserves the right to invite the L2 bidder for balance work to match the rates of L1 bidder and, if agreed, the same will be allotted to L2 bidder as per his eligibility criteria. 1.1.4	The bidder shall submit the copy of PAN card along with bid.
1.1.5	The bidder should be registered under P. F. Act.
1.1.6	The bidder should be registered under Workman Compensation Policy / ESIC registration certificate.
1.1.7	EMD: EMD in lieu of bid security deposit @1% of estimated cost will have to be paid by the bidder through online mode only. OR
	The bidder will have to furnish Bank Guarantee of any nationalized/scheduled Bank in prescribed format equivalent to 1% of the estimated cost in lieu of bid security deposit payable at Mumbai at the time of submission of bid documents with validity of 12 months from the scheduled date of opening of techno-commercial bids.

- 1. The micro and small enterprises (only manufacturing and service enterprises) as defined in MSMED Act, 2006 are exempted from paying EMD and tender fees. The Udyog Aadhar Memorandum and Udyog Aadhar Registration certificate submitted by said enterprises should indicate the same Material/Service as required against the tender floated.
- 2. The Bidder has to pay EMD and tender fees in following cases:
- a. If the Micro/Small Enterprise Registration Certificate does not indicate the relevant classification code covering Material/Service as required against the tender floated.

- 3. In case of Works Contract, if the Micro and /Small Enterprise submits that the enterprise shall supply all the materials of intended works Contract, manufactured from its own unit, then it shall be eligible for exemption of payment of EMD & Tender Fees to MSETCL. However, an undertaking duly notarized from Micro and Small Enterprise to this effect is to be submitted along with bid.
- 4. The Works Contractor except as stated above and Traders are excluded from the benefits of EMD and Tender fees, hence shall be required to pay EMD or tender fees while participating for e-tender process at MSETCL.
- 5. The registration Certificate as submitted by micro and small enterprises should be valid on the date of submission of bid and the validity of the same should be certified by the Chartered Accountant in practice.

Note: In case, the micro and small enterprise (who have been exempted from payment of EMD/Tender Fees) does not accept the tender being L1, the such micro and small enterprise shall be debarred from the bidding process for all tenders at MSETCL for next 2 years from the date of non-acceptance of L1 bid and this is to be clearly mentioned in all tenders.

3.4	A declaration to the effect that the Bidder does not anticipate change in his ownership during the proposed period of the work till successful completion of warranty period (If such a change is anticipated, the scope and effect thereof, shall be defined) shall be submitted with the offer.
3.5	In case bidder is a holding company, MAAT and the Net worth referred to in clause 3.1 and 3.2 above shall be that of holding company only (i.e. excluding its subsidiary/group companies).
3.6	In case bidder is a subsidiary of a holding company, MAAT and Net Worth referred to in clause 3.1 and 3.2 above shall be that of subsidiary company only (i.e. excluding its holding company).
3.7	The Bidder should have to submit the audited financial statements i.e. Profit & Loss Account & Balance sheets for last three financial years duly certified by Chartered Accountant with seal and UDIN.
3.8	Income Tax Returns: The Bidder shall submit the copy of Income Tax returns for the last three Financial year, from the last day of month previous to the one in which Tenders are invited.
3.9	The bidder should note that no deviation in tender conditions will be allowed after bid submission.
4.0	Notwithstanding anything stated above, the owner reserves the right to assess the bidder's capability and capacity to perform the work, should the circumstances warrant such an assessment in the overall interest of the owner and may reject the offer without assigning any reason.

5.0 The Performance Bank Guarantee for the proper fulfillment of the contract shall be furnished by the Contractor in the prescribed form within stipulated time period of Notice of Award of Contract/Letter of Award. The performance Guarantee shall be as per standard proforma. This guarantee shall be for an amount equal to 10% (ten percent) of the contract price. In case of JV, the Lead bidder will have to submit PBG of 06% (Six percent) of the Contract Price and the JV partner will have to submit PBG of 04% (Four percent) of the Contract Price within stipulated time period.
